urinary system and how it works - kidney & urology - kidney stones is the term commonly used to refer to stones, or calculi, in the urinary system. stones form in the kidneys and may be found anywhere in the urinary system. they vary in size. some stones cause great pain while others cause very little. the aim of treatment is to remove the stones, prevent infection, and prevent recurrence. **chapter urinary system - contributions to metabolism **the urinary system - pearson** - the urinary system is composed of the paired and the kidneysurinary tract. the kidneys filter the blood to remove metabolic wastes and then modify the resulting fluid, which al-lows these organs to maintain fluid, electrolyte, acid-base, and blood pressure homeostasis. **urinary system anatomy -
